Demonstration Projects

- Transition to Less Waste (TTLW) once again achieved a waste diversion level of over 99% during the Canterbury Folk Festival, through our volunteer powered **Festival Waste Reduction Program**.
- Our organization was pleased to partner with Tourism Oxford in order to create a **Zero Waste Event Planning Guide**, currently available for public use.
- Our **Dish Lending Program** has kept tens of thousands of single use dishes and cutlery from entering the waste stream.
- Our **Community Demonstration Garden** provided a model food security solution in the form of an organic kitchen garden, located in downtown Ingersoll.
